CUMBERLAND GALLERY ART SHOW 2018 GUIDELINES

Please read and follow the guidelines below.

The art show committee reserves the right to withdraw any entry not following the stated guidelines.

ALL PARTICIPANTS:

1. Paintings may be of any medium—watercolor, acrylic, oil, pastel, etc. Drawings may include pen/pencil, charcoal, chalk, etc. 3D art can include collages, small sculptures, etc. (Please call Gwen or Susan at 864-5759 for more information on this category.)
2. Entries may framed or unframed. If entries are framed they must be wired for hanging or have a secure hanging hook. Entries can also be matted on or mounted on foam board.
3. No wet paintings will be accepted.
4. The artist's name, phone number, and category must be firmly WRITTEN on the back of the entry. Do not attach the application form to the back of the entry. If entering two pieces, please indicate which entry is #1 and which entry is #2.
5. Entries must be brought to the library during regular library hours from Monday, April 16th through Tuesday, April 24th. The library is open from 9am-8pm Monday through Friday, 9am-5pm on Saturday, and 1-5pm on Sunday. No entries will be accepted after April 24th (no exceptions).
6. Entries must be picked up during regular library hours between Monday, April 30th and Wednesday, May 2nd. The bank, library, and committee will not be responsible for entries left after that time. Failure to pick up entries in a timely manner may result in disqualification from future shows.
7. This competition is for amateurs only. A professional is one who teaches, sells, or otherwise earns a sizeable portion of income by his/her art or who has done so in the past.
8. The art show committee reserves the right to select paintings to be hung. Cumberland Valley National Bank, the Laurel County Public Library, and the art show committee cannot be responsible for loss or damage but will take precautions for protection.

Artists are encouraged to attend the opening reception on Thursday, April 26th from 5-7pm when the category winners and Best of Show winner will be revealed.

The event is free and open to the public.
